LET'S STICK WITH THE CLEAR PLAN:

The last few years have been tough for British families. And with global uncertainty on the rise, only a clear plan with bold action will deliver the secure future Brits need.

Keeping inflation low. Under Rishi Sunak, inflation has been more than halved — from 11.1% in October 2022 to close to 2% now. And we'll make sure inflation stays low. Helping to ease the pressure on family budgets, spur business investment, lower interest rates and grow our economy.

Abolishing National Insurance, an unfair double tax on work. Right now, your pay is taxed twice: first through income tax and then through National Insurance. This isn't fair, and the Conservatives are taking action. So far, we've cut National Insurance from 12% to 8%. That's a tax cut of £900 for workers on an average salary of £35,400. And if you vote to stick with the plan, we'll cut it again. Rishi Sunak has set out his long-term ambition to keep cutting the unfair double tax on work until it's gone.

Doubling the amount of free childcare parents can access. Childcare is one of the biggest expenses most parents face. So we're supporting families by doubling the amount of free childcare. From the time kids are nine months old till the time they start school, parents will get

30 hours of free childcare a week. This means parents will never have to choose between work and raising a family.

Introducing productivity reforms to our NHS. Our NHS needs to be prepared for the future. That's why the Conservatives are introducing productivity reforms, removing outdated IT and introducing new equipment like AI-enabled MRI scanners. Rishi Sunak has also introduced the first long-term workforce plan in NHS history, doubling the number of training places for doctors and nurses. So our NHS will be protected for generations to come.

Increasing defence spending to 2.5% of GDP by 2030. From cyber attacks on our own soil to wars in Europe and the Middle East, the world is growing more uncertain. So the next government needs to guarantee our military has the funds to meet new threats. That's why the Conservatives will increase defence spending to 2.5% of GDP — making the UK the biggest defence power in Europe.

Guaranteeing the pensions Triple Lock. The Conservatives introduced the Triple Lock in 2010. Only the Conservatives will protect it. Rishi Sunak has guaranteed the Triple Lock, which this year has meant a £900 increase in the state pension.
